


Explore Serengeti

AT ROVING BUSHTOPS







Location

Having pioneered the idea of 'wild luxury' at Mara Bushtops, then extended it to Serengeti Bushtops, we were determined that our third Bushtops location should be at least their equal – for game viewing and comfort alike.

So we were delighted to find a stunning first base at Seronera in the Central Serengeti, not far from the Moru Kopjes area (often called the jewel in the crown of the Serengeti).

The kopjes are huge granite rock formations which burst through the grass plains, creating vistas of stunning beauty beneath rolling hills. The land traps water, attracting abundant wildlife and ensuring fabulous viewing throughout the year.

For those who love nature in its purest form, the heart of the Serengeti is without peer or parallel.

The sheer quantity of game here is phenomenal, with resident and migrating herbivores stalked by loping leopards, charismatic cheetah and languid lions.

Roving Bushtops is also easy to reach at any time, being just 40 minutes' game drive from the Serenora Airstrip with flights landing from Kogatende, Lake Manyara, Arusha, Kilimanjaro (JRO) Dar Es Saalam, Zanzibar and Nairobi.

As our name implies, we make our own annual migration each winter, heading south to Kusini to gain the best possible vantage point from which to see the migration and to witness the wildebeest birthing season round February.

Roving Bushtops schedule at a glance

Central Serengeti
1st June to 30th October 2023/ 2024

Southern Serengeti/Kusini 21st December 2023 to 31st March 2024

As with all our camps, Roving Bushtops is a place to reconnect with what really matters: nature, people, spirit and time.

Venue

Guests stay in eight superbly-specified tents, featuring king-size beds and 24 hour power. Each en-suite bathroom includes a flushing toilet, bath, vanity basins and showers.

We make sure there is absolutely no compromise on indulgence, with every need being catered for through 24 hour butler service.

During the day, tent walls can be opened on three sides, enabling panoramic views of the surrounding bush.


Experience

However tempting it may be to luxuriate in camp, the true glory of Roving Bushtops is its immediate access to the world's greatest wildlife spectacles. There is no need to travel to the animals: they are all around you. We drive amongst them, not to reach them.

Daily game drives are led by expert rangers, supported by keen-eyed local spotters. We have always sourced and converted some of the best gameviewing vehicles in East Africa, so each day's roving takes place in superblyequipped, ultra-reliable open 4x4 Land Cruisers.

As each day draws to a close, you and your fellow guests can re-gather at Roving Bushtops' dining tent. Here you select from a sophisticated menu in a haven of contemporary luxury, set against arguably the world's greatest safari backdrop. Alternatively you can wine and dine in the privacy of your own tent.

And when you leave, we know that unforgettable memories will combine with the knowledge that you have left no environmental footprint whatsoever, helping to preserve one of the most special places on earth.







Tents

- 8 tents (twin and double on request) max of 1 extra bed (child or adult) can be added to each tent
- All tents can be converted to become family units. The tents are on wheels and can be moved next to each other.

Children

Children are welcome from the age of 7 and we grant children's rates up to the age of 17

Tent Facilities

- The tents open up on 3 sides. The bathroom has a bathtub and shower. The tent walls can be opened up to get the feeling of being outside
- The tents are beautifully furnished in a contemporary style and have loungers and dining table on the wooden deck which spans over 100 square metres
- All tents are equipped with a safe, hair dryer, 220v AC

Camp Facilities

- 24 hr power and complimentary wifi (due to the remote location of the camp, the wireless connection can be slow and intermittent)
- 24 hr butler service and private dining in the tent on request
- Mini shop with specially selected local crafts and souvenirs
- Mini library
- Complimentary laundry service
- Cellphone reception available (the signal may be intermittent and limited to WhatsApp calls in Kusini)
- Check in is at 2pm and checkout 10am, but we do everything possible to remain flexible

Dining

- All dining is included and on an à la carte basis
- Dining is in the elegant mess tent, in the privacy of your tent or under the stars
- All non alcoholic drinks, beers, premium wines and all spirits included (French champagne not included)
- Please let us know your dietary requirements in advance. We can adapt to most requests

Best Time To Visit

- December to March at Kusini to get the best possible vantage point for the migration and witness the birthing season (around February)
- June to November in the central Serengeti which is rich in wildlife all year round. Due to the central location, game drives can be conducted in various areas including the Central Serengeti as well as the eastern and western corridor
- June and November in the central Serengeti for the migration in the immediate area or within a game drive's reach
- Temperatures range from min. approx $8^{\circ}\text{C}/42^{\circ}\text{F}$ to max. approx $30^{\circ}\text{C}/86^{\circ}\text{F}$
- Rainfall predominantly occurs in November, April and May
- Closed in April and May and parts of November and December

Guest Safety

Roving Bushtops is not fenced off and guests are requested to be vigilant at all times. Guests must be accompanied by our security staff when moving from their tent to the main building in the early mornings, evenings and night

Activities

- Game drives are on a private basis
- Bush picnics, sun downers
- Complimentary massages
- Balloon safari package includes: transfers, pre flight briefing,
 1-1½ hrs balloon flight and champagne style bush breakfast
- Bushcraft Challenge for Children
- Guided nature walk around Camp grounds
